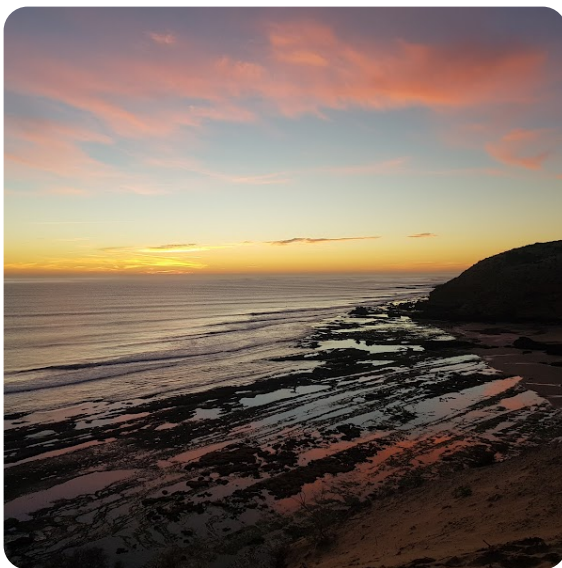
## Dog Walks

Enjoy peaceful walks with our rescued dogs along quiet paths and the nearby wild beach—a joyful moment for both guests and furry friends.



### **CAPSIMBAY House | beach cabins & dog sanctuary**

Guests are welcome to join our daily dog walks alongside our rescued dogs, a truly special experience that connects you with nature and our mission. Together, we explore the nearby sand dunes and the surrounding forest, where wide open landscapes, fresh ocean air, and peaceful trails create a moment of pure calm. Walking with the rescues is not only joyful and grounding, but also a beautiful way to support their rehabilitation and well-being. It's an unforgettable walk filled with wagging tails, freedom, and the quiet magic of this untouched part of Cap Sim.



### **Ras Sim**

From Capsimbay, a scenic coastal walk leads you to the iconic Cap Sim Lighthouse, located just about 3 km away (around 35–45 minutes on foot). The hike follows the Atlantic shoreline, offering breathtaking views of the ocean, cliffs, sand dunes, and wide open skies. It's an easy and peaceful walk, perfect at sunrise or late afternoon, where the light turns golden and the sound of the waves accompanies you all the way. Reaching the lighthouse feels rewarding and timeless — a quiet moment surrounded by raw nature, fresh sea air, and one of the most beautiful coastal landscapes near Essaouira.



## Iftane

Just a short drive from Capsimbay Beach House, you'll find the charming coastal area of Sidi Ahmed Essayeh, home to the beautiful Iftane Beach — a wide sandy bay nestled between dramatic cliffs and framed by the blue Atlantic. This scenic fishing village is perfect for a relaxed day by the sea, beachcombing, or simply soaking in the views of the coastline. From Ouassane, it's an easy outing by car (about 25–30 minutes). While you're there, don't miss the chance to enjoy some of the freshest fish at a local fisherman café called Lhoucine, where simple, authentic seafood is served right by the water.



## Plage d'Essaouira

A visit to Essaouira is a true delight, just a short drive from Capsimbay. Lose yourself in its charming medina, enjoy the fresh sea breeze, taste the local seafood, and watch the sun set over the Atlantic—a perfect day to remember.

-Explore the Medina – Wander the UNESCO-listed old town with its narrow streets, colorful doors, and artisan shops.

-Visit the Port – Watch fishermen at work and enjoy the lively harbor atmosphere.

-Try Fresh Seafood – Taste local fish and seafood at small cafés along the waterfront.

-Relax on the Beaches – Stroll, sunbathe, or try windsurfing and kitesurfing on the wide sandy beaches.

-Discover Art & Culture – Visit galleries, watch street performances, or enjoy local music festivals.

-Climb the Ramparts – Walk along the old city walls for stunning views of the ocean and the medina.

## Surf spot



### Sidi Kaouki plage

### Le Domaine du Val d'Argan

Val d'Argan is a renowned winery located just outside Essaouira, set amid rolling countryside and argan tree groves. The estate combines Moroccan terroir with French winemaking expertise, producing a range of refined wines including Val d'Argan Rouge and Argania Blanc. Visitors can enjoy guided vineyard and cellar tours, wine tastings, and a tranquil rural setting that offers a pleasant escape from the coast. It's a lovely outing for guests interested in Moroccan wine, nature, and local craftsmanship.

### Taxi or rental car

Whether you choose a quiet ride into town or an adventure along the coast, getting around is simple and stress-free.
